<u>Position Summary</u>: This is the entry level position into the Maintenance Department for the Ashtabula Metropolitan Housing Authority.

Responsibilities may include: driving a company vehicle, grounds care, custodial duties and maintenance tasks as assigned. Duties include but are not limited to: lawn mowing with push-type and riding mowers, leaf blowing, edging, trimming, raking and debris pick-up, reseeding and fertilizing, snow plowing, snow blowing; installing and repairing curbing, pavement and sidewalks; cleaning out vacant units, painting, floor cleaning, repairs as needed; cleaning offices and common areas in project offices; janitorial duties; providing labor support to other maintenance mechanics and any other tasks as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Licensed to drive in Ohio with a clean driving record.
- Knowledge of cleaning materials, equipment and methods commonly employed in the custodial care and cleaning of buildings, facilities and equipment.
- Knowledge of general grounds care procedures and maintenance.

- Knowledge of basic tools.
- Ability to exercise care in the use of materials, equipment and tools.
- Ability to paint multiple surface types.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to perform tasks requiring moderately heavy manual work.
- Ability to lift at least 50 lbs.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees, tenants and the general public.
